Chart description of the course	

Short description of the course:

To ensure the multidisciplinary nature of the program, speakers from various fields represent professionals who familiarize students with different aspects of disadvantage (social, educational, economic) and their management approaches. This is followed by an intensive study period at Partium Christian University, where students engage in exchange of experiences, jointly develop and implement a project in a selected disadvantaged community, specifically in Kéc, Bihar County. The target community consists of young people attending elementary school. The disadvantaged situation in the community arises from its social and economic characteristics, with a significant Roma population residing there. Students participate in an inclusive program implemented in the community, which includes an after-school program where educators, psychologists, social workers, and clergy provide daily support to students in

grades 0-4. As part of this program, the students plan and organize activities according to their defined roles.

The planned extracurricular activities can include programs aimed at career guidance, introducing the world of work, or promoting health and lifestyle. Other creative programs can also be implemented.

Short description of the virtual component:

The online study period includes a team-building workshop where participating students get to know each other, receive information about the program elements, and form small groups to begin their collaborative work. The digital component of the program also involves the delivery of four lectures. Speakers from Romania, Slovakia, and Hungary participate in the program.

During the intensive program, innovative learning and teaching methods are employed, and collaborative teamwork takes place in both online and physical spaces.

Programm conteint:

- A. Online introductory workshop (September 2023- 3. Week)
- B. Online lectures (period September 4. week-October 1-2 Weeks 2023)
- C. Online students- teamwork (period September 4. week-October 1-2 Weeks 2023)

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
